

## 2018 Solomon Fund Grantees

In 2018, the Solomon Fund granted over \$95,000 to 18 local organizations who are intentionally working to increase Latinx participation in their sports and recreation programs.

<b>Organization</b>	<b>Program/Project</b>
Ballet West	Scholarships for Latina girls, aged 5-12 years, to participate in Ballet West summer camps and academic year programs
Egyptian Theatre	Increase Latinx student participation in year-round classes and YouTheatre camps as well as specific three-phase community theatre project, including after-school program at Ecker Hill Middle School and a 2-week summer camp
Holy Cross Ministries	Increase low-income Latinx participation by introducing over 100 elementary school students to tennis and swimming at PC MARC during the Summer Camp Program
Kimball Art Center	Scholarships for 5-12-year-old low-income Latinx students in summer art camps
National Ability Center	Engage Latinx children with disabilities in adaptive programs through: targeted outreach and marketing initiatives, half-day open house in Spanish, and support scholarships
Park City Ice Arena	Hire Spanish-speaking part-time staff member to enhance communication and outreach efforts
Park City Ninja Kids	Funding to pay for martial arts belt rank testing for 20-25 students in program
Park City Recreation	Increasing access to youth programs for underserved populations by identifying barriers of communication, transportation, and scholarships
Park City Running Club	Scholarships for McPolin elementary running pilot program
Park City Soccer Club	Scholarships for Latinx children during the new summer session and throughout the year
Snyderville Basin Special Recreation District	Hire Spanish-speaking part-time staff member for Latinx outreach and Spanish language program promotion and provide additional scholarships to Latinx students
SOS Outreach	Scholarships for low-income Latinx Park City youth to participate in outdoor mentoring programs
Summit Bike Club	Scholarships for Latinx students, as well as additional coaching staff to maintain 5:1 athlete to coach ratio
Summit Land Conservancy	Scholarships for low-income Latinx youth to attend summer outdoor adventure camps at 80% discount, in addition to bike rental and program supplies
Swaner Preserve & EcoCenter	Tuition waivers for low-income Latinx youth for summer camps, materials, and welcome night
The Little Gym	Scholarships for Latinx children to participate in gymnastics classes

Utah Olympic Legacy Foundation	Scholarships for 10 students for the two-day a week Kickers & Gliders program, as well as funding half of the camp FUNDamentals camp fee
Youth Sports Alliance	Transportation underwriting to increase Latino sign ups, gear acquisition, fee waivers ranging from \$50-180, multilingual registration system, and Spanish-speaking outreach assistant staff member
