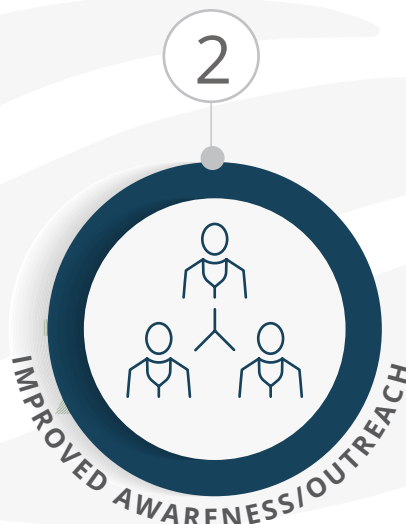
# YOUTH UNITED

Formerly known as Solomon Fund and RISE Fund, Youth United is the unified program that offers school-age children and teens in Park City and Summit County access to sports, recreation, clubs, camps, and extracurricular activities. The Community Foundation has dedicated staff who operate Youth United, convening partners, promoting programs, translating materials, and hosting community outreach events.

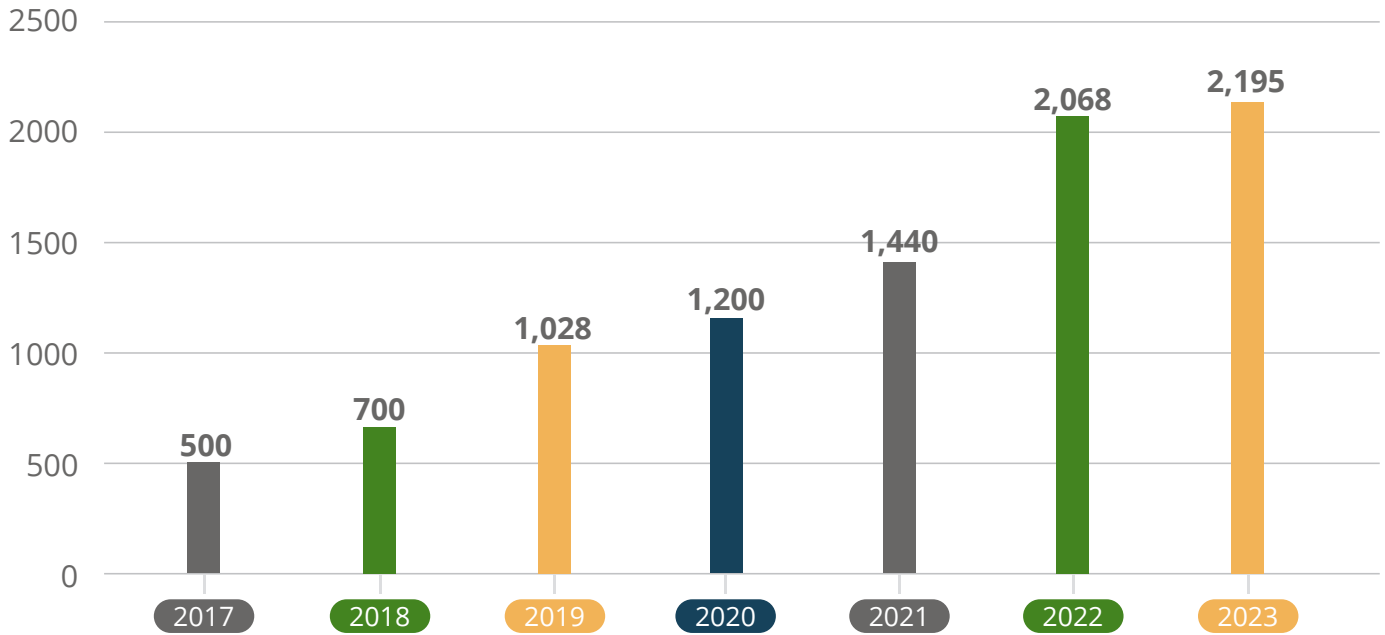


The goal of Youth United is to foster a sense of belonging among local youth and strengthen connections between community members. With Youth United, there are no limits to the many opportunities in our area to play, learn, make friends, and belong. Youth United is for Latina/o/x kids, BIPOC kids, and kids of any background who are navigating financial constraints. In addition to extracurriculars, the participants' families are also connected to important community resources, like healthcare, legal support, housing resources, and more.

## TOP 3 FACTORS THAT CONTRIBUTED TO INCREASED YOUTH UNITED PARTICIPATION IN 2023



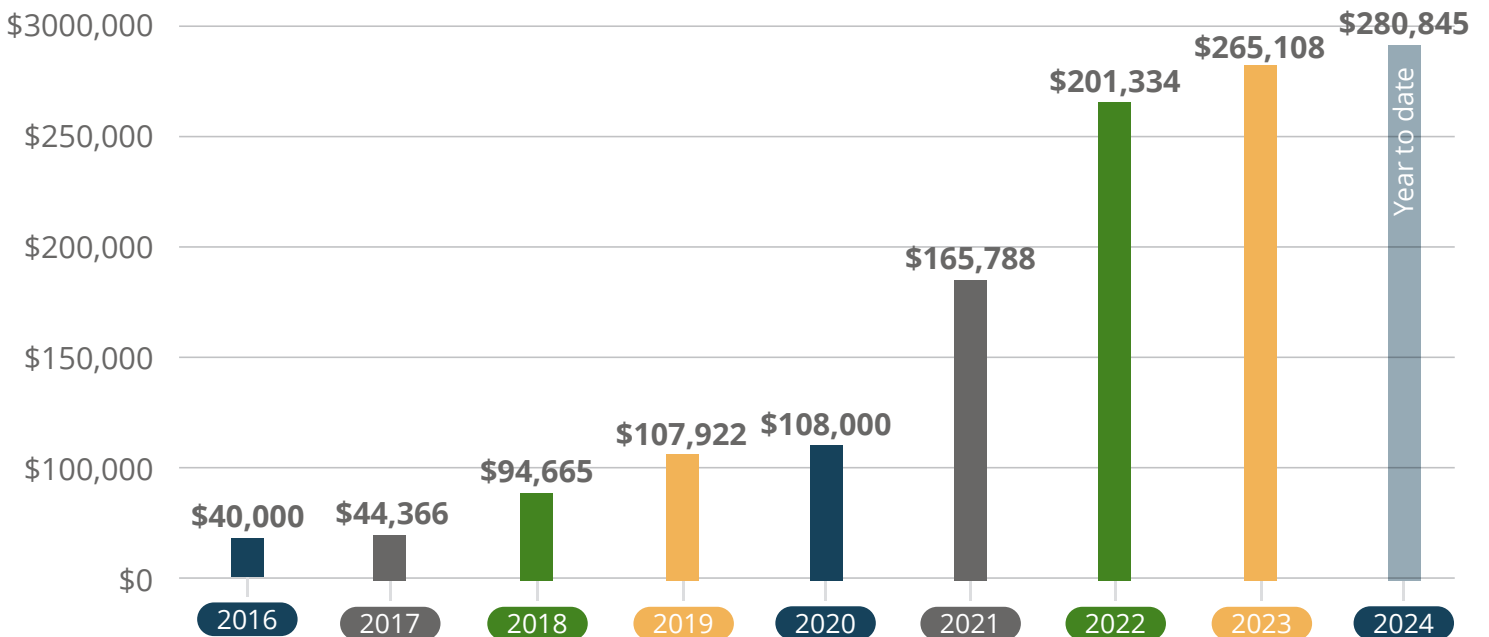
## YOUTH UNITED REGISTRATIONS BY YEAR



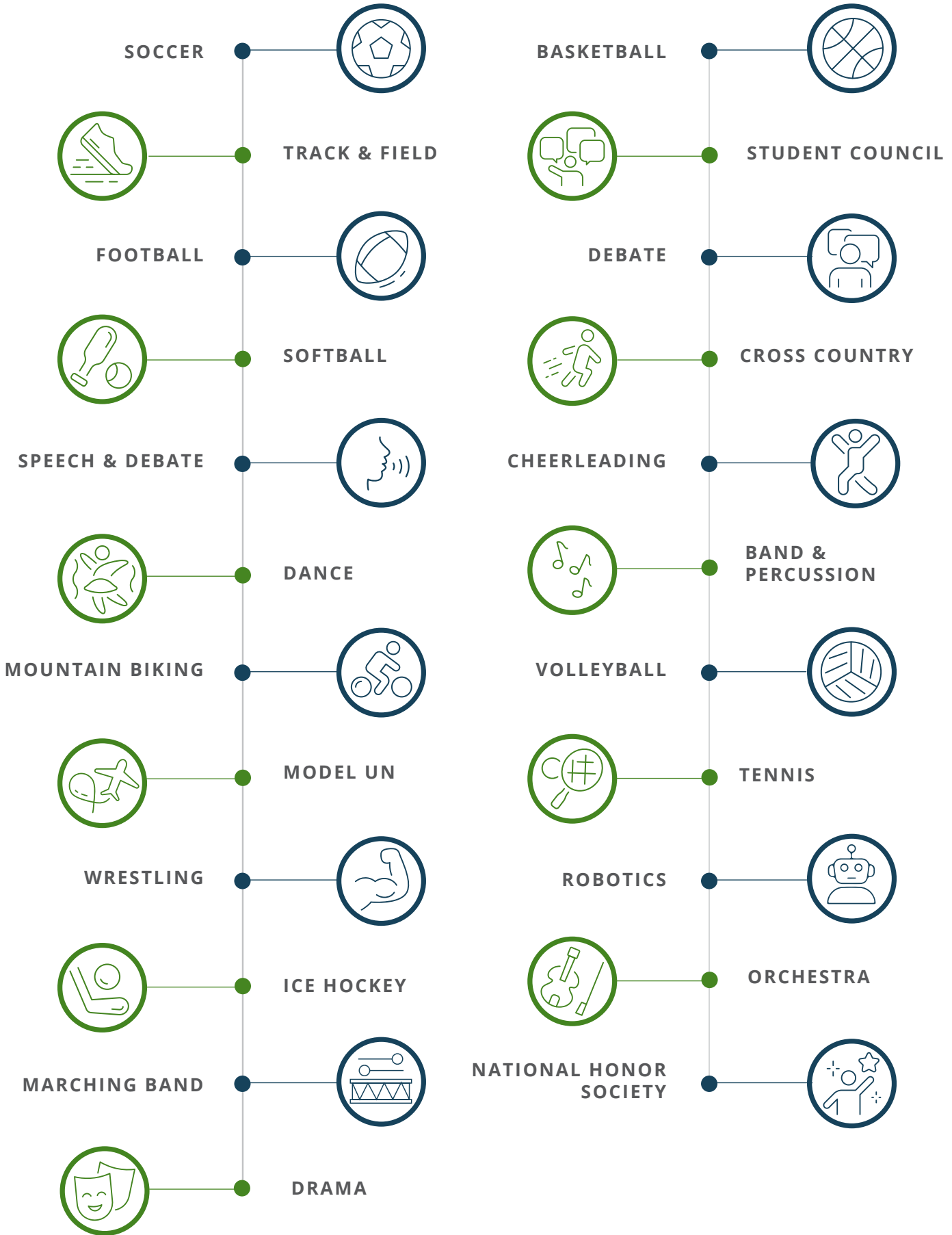
Over \$1.3 M granted out since inception!
