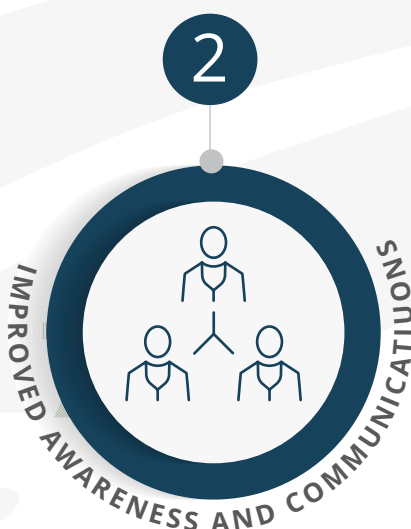


2025-2026 IMPACT REPORT YOUTH UNITED

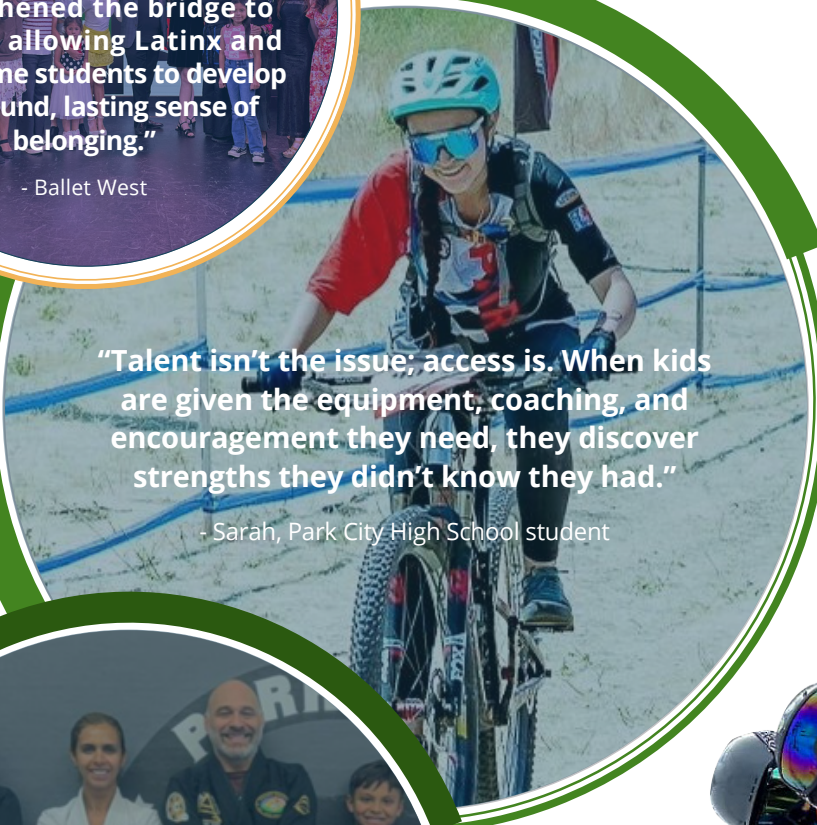
